



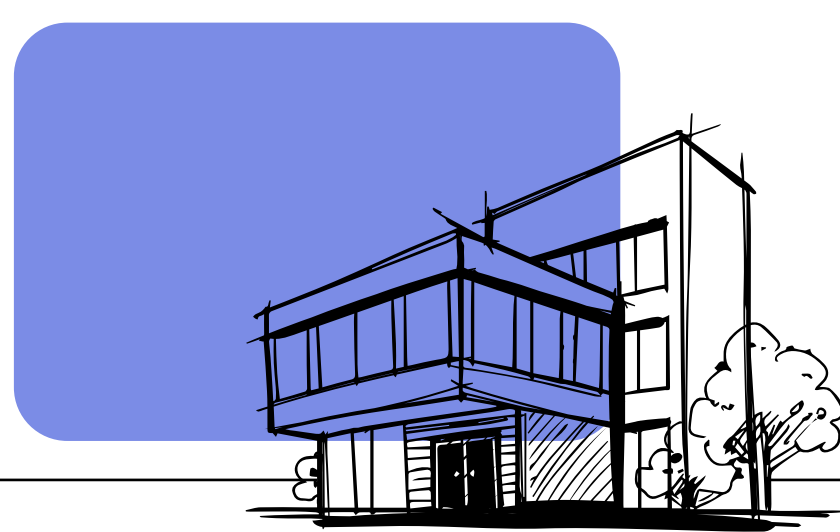

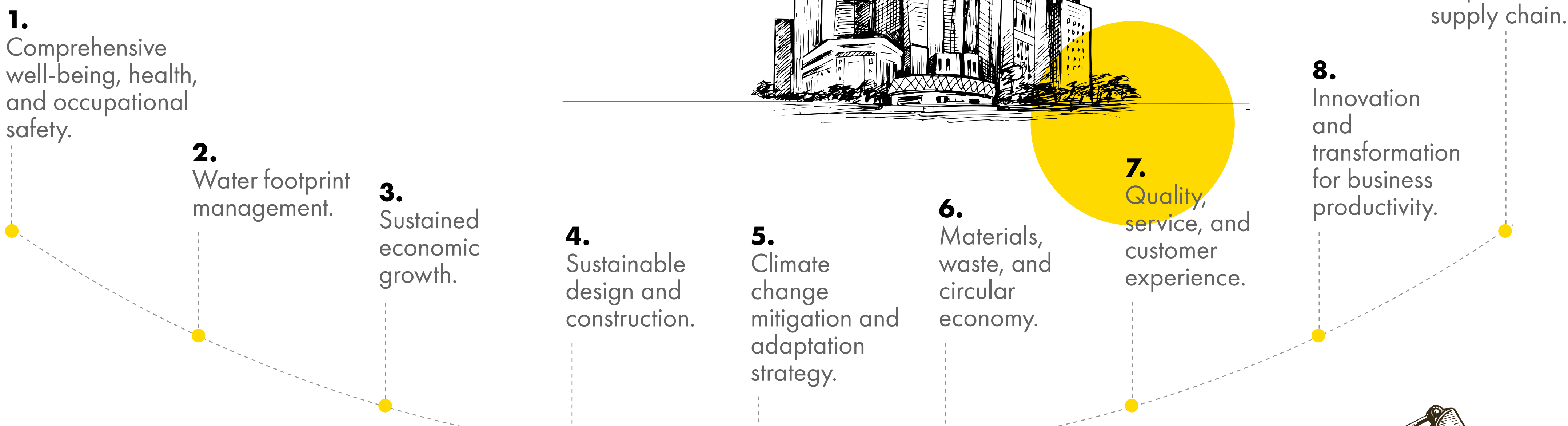

+535.000 tons of waste diverted from landfills.

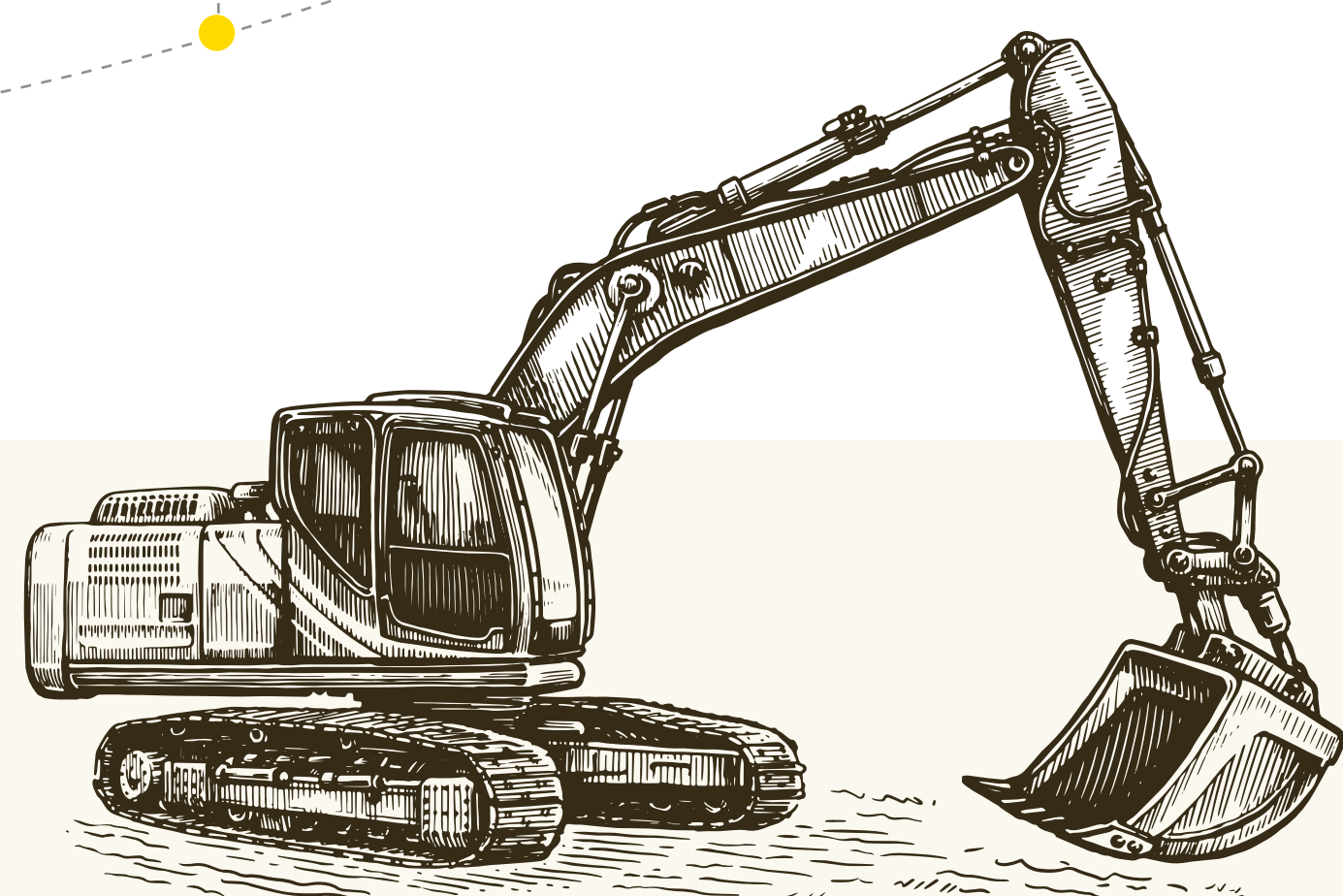
